Home computing Initiatives January 2004

Patricia Hewitt published guidelines on the Home Computing Initiatives (HCI). These schemes are enabled by the Government's 1999 tax exemption on loaned computers, which allows employers to implement a tax-exempt loan scheme for computer equipment for their employees to use at home. This permits employers to offer flexible working as well as improve organisational performance through improved ICT skills. Guidance on HCI is available on the DTI website
